WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT?



From the Cohort:

- A willingness to work on a project related to strengthening worship in your context. You don't need a "big idea" beforehand - we'll help!
- Five meetings with CWA—a mixture of on-site and online.
- Find ways to share your project with the big "C" Church - we'll help!
- Attend Animate 2025 and connect with other cohorts.

From the Adult Cohort Leaders:

- Invest in young people who have a passion for worship and the arts.
- Coordinate meetings where cohort members can attend in-person.
- Communicate with students and parents the aims of the cohort.
- Support the completion of the project, with our help.

WHAT DOES THE CWA OFFER?

- An extensive network of consultants and coaches.
- Project management to help your team meet their goals.
- A distribution method for resources your cohort may produce.
- \$3000 in funding to help you meet your goals.
 - Can be used for paying consultants, purchasing equipment, renting a retreat center, etc. (must be tangible things that we at the Center can purchase/arrange for you).
- \$3600 toward attending Animate 2025.
 - Can be used for expenses related to registration, travel, and/or meals.
- Connection opportunities with other cohorts to share your projects.

grow in your skills, and meet with other
cohorts to learn about their projects.



Continued Work / Conclude

July '25-Dec '25: Continue the project.
Schedule second site visit in Fall '25.
Conclude by December '25 and evaluate next
steps.

WHY ARE WE DOING THIS?

When pastors and mentors invest in the creative gifts of teenagers and empower them to lead, we know there's a stronger chance these students will remain connected to the Church in their adulthood. We want to come alongside you in empowering young people to lead the church of today.
